The '20s are here! Ever since the year 2000, when the world did not end due to a computer catastrophe, it seems our eyes have been fixed on this year, 2020, and this decade of the '20s. In fact, as I looked back at my *Postscripts* article for the beginning of the last decade, I didn't even mention that a new decade was starting! Apparently, it was a non-event to me. For some reason, though, this decade stretches out before me like a sea of hope and opportunity.

I am excited about what God can and will do in our church in the next decade. Typically, we overestimate what can be accomplished in a year but underestimate what can be accomplished in a decade. Think about what all we accomplished in the '10s as a church, especially the \$5.5 million renovation of our facilities. I assure you, as we turned the calendar to 2010, no one thought we would be able to do that.

We hoped we would, but we weren't too sure. However, that should remind us what can happen in a decade.



As I look ahead, I also find myself looking back and asking, "What were the 1920s like and will the 2020s be anything like that?" As you know, the 1920s in America were known as the Roaring Twenties. It was a time of growth, prosperity, and distinctive culture. A similar thing was true for FBC Pineville. Founded in 1911, the second decade of our church was one of amazing growth. In 1919, the church moved into its first permanent building, a multi-story structure with an 800-seat auditorium. This building sat where the Cowley building does today. With bold faith, the church took on enormous debt to build the building, however, by 1926, the building was paid off. As the twenties roared on, the church experienced explosive growth in membership, especially through new coverts. The quickly changing culture proved challenging to the church, but also provided a field that was ripe unto harvest. One revival in 1928 saw crowds of 1500-2000 people and 250 new additions to the church. In total the church membership grew by 73%!

As we look ahead to our own '20s, what could happen? We too have a large debt to be eliminated so we may move forward with other projects. Could we eliminate ours by mid-decade like our predecessors? We too minister within a culture that is rapidly changing. Will we see that as an obstacle or as an opportunity? Could we see a 73% increase in membership, largely from new converts? What a joy it would be to see such life transformation happening!

As we begin a new decade, begin praying now about all God will do among us as a church family. As I look around at what God has done and is doing in our church, I have to say, "It's a great time to Be F.I.R.S.T.!"




