### BE F.I.R.S.T.



As the summer presses on, ministry does as well. In the last month, our children and students have both attended camp, all of them experiencing fresh touches of the Lord in their lives. On Sundays, we are enjoying God's blessing of vibrant worship and of guests every week and new members almost every week. I sense God doing a fresh work in our church.

Earlier this month, our ministry staff met to do some calendaring and lay out our goals for 2019-2020. The goals are BHAGs (Big Hairy Audacious Goals)! They are God-sized. They certainly are Neiman Marcus prayers instead of Dollar General prayers! (If you don't know what that means, listen or watch the message from July 7 at fbcpineville.net). Such goals include:



- Increasing Sunday School Attendance by 25%
- Increasing baptisms by 200%
- Decreasing debt while increasing missions
- Developing and training new leadership for new and existing ministries
- Expanding ministries to children, students, and their parents
- Growing our on-line outreach through our media ministry
- · Implementing new outreach and membership assimilation plans
- Growing our choir to an average of 50 people and our instrumentalist participation to an average of 15.

And those are just some of the goals shared by our ministry staff! The remainder of 2019 and all of 2020 will be an exciting season. We are anticipating a lot of new: expanded ministries, opportunities for service, Sunday School class options, international and national mission partnerships, and more. We've even been discussing and researching two possibilities for expanding our worship reach both online and here on our campus.

What do we need to accomplish all of this? Five things. First, we need to *pray*. BHAGs take God's work to accomplish. Second, we need to *give*. New and existing ministries require us to be faithful in our tithes and offerings. Third, we need to be faithful in attendance. It is hard to gain traction with sporadic attendance. Fourth, we need to *serve*. New and expanding ministries provide numerous places for you to serve the Lord. Finally, we need to *share* with our friends and neighbors and on social media what's happening here at First Pineville! I mean, after all, it's a great time to Be F.I.R.S.T.!

class discussions, and interactive small group activities to explore biblical principles and practical steps for handling money.


