I am so grateful for the ministries of our church. When I review our church calendar or read our publications, I am amazed at all God has us doing. However, some ministries fly under the radar of the calendar or publications. Others are mentioned here and there, but few people may know about them. I want to celebrate a few of those here.

First, several months ago a couple of our women approached me with the idea of Mom Time. It was to be a relaxed time on Wednesday nights for FBCP moms to hang out, build relationships, and have a devotional. I said, "Sounds great. Run with it." They did. Honestly, I'm rather naïve and think, "Oh, that won't happen here," but I am at ease knowing that this team is in place in case that does happen here.

Finally, our Bible Drill ministry is worthy of note. Only a handful of our children participate in this ministry, but it is an important ministry for providing a faith foundation. 




