Summer is a time for a lot of great things but especially evangelistic impact. That impact begins this Sunday, May 19, with an evangelistic challenge. Since we will wrap up our sermon series on John, Tom and Judi Kent have donated 400 copies of the gospel of John for us to distribute to people this summer! I'll be challenging you to commit to have an evangelistic conversation with at least one person this summer using the gospel of John.



Our next summer evangelistic impact will be VBS (June 2-6, 5:30-8:30 p.m.)! There is no better evangelistic tool than VBS! Last year, well over 65,000 children trusted Jesus Christ as a result of Vacation Bible Schools. "If you total it up, VBS results in 15 hours of intense discipleship, the gospel being shared daily, and 7 months of ministry in 1 week!" (Holmes, *It's Worth It*, 108). If you're not a part of VBS, you need to be! Contact Kimberly Aguillard to get involved! All of us should be praying now for a great week!

After VBS comes the summer camps! Kids Camp is June 17-20 at Tall Timbers for our 3rd through 6th graders. Our students will participate in camp at Glorieta, NM, June 7-14. Major life decisions including salvations, rededications, and surrenders to ministry callings happen at camp each year!

In addition to these events, several of our church members will be going on mission this summer. This month Marie Johnson is delivering Operation Christmas Child Shoeboxes in Namibia, Southwest Africa. In July, I will be joining other pastors for a vision trip with Compassion International to El Salvador. Later that month, Thomas Martin will serve as a chaplain at the International Boy Scout Jamboree being held this year in West Virginia. Throughout the summer, several of our students will be serving at Christian camps. I am sure others of you will be serving in other places that I don't know about (so please let me know so I can be praying!).

As we go through this summer, be intentional about having evangelistic impact. Our church's impact will literally be international this summer. That's just one more reason - *it's a great time to Be F.I.R.S.T.!*
