Campus Description Related to Music Ministry


Technology: The Lecompte campus has a new professionally designed and installed sound system. Due to the ambient light in the room from stained glass windows, the stage lighting is limited to basic area lighting. The video system for congregational and platform support is also newly updated.

Worship: FBC Pineville aims to provide a blended style of worship using traditional hymns, new hymn arrangements, as well as contemporary worship songs. We value congregational worship participation through singing and a choir. The Lecompte campus is blessed with both a gifted drummer and guitarist. Currently, volunteer pianists from Pineville are rotating to serve at Lecompte. A praise team assists in leading worship. Our goal is to develop a choir for the Lecompte campus as this is part of the worship DNA of FBC Pineville. The Lecompte campus currently has about seven singers, several of them quite gifted, who rotate through the praise team. Pineville members also serve as part of the praise team in rotation.

Facilities: The Lecompte sanctuary has a large platform that is suitable for numerous types of events. The room easily seats 300. In the past the church presented multi-night seasonal presentations as well as *Heaven's Gates and Hells Flames*. The church also has an approximately 150 seat chapel, fellowship hall, half-court gym, and ample education space. The church also has a large outdoor space suitable for various gatherings or events.

Resources: Because FBC Lecompte is a campus of FBC Pineville, the resources of the Pineville campus are available. Those include office resources, equipment, volunteers, and more.


Overview

First Baptist Church Pineville has been a flagship for mission work in Central Louisiana and beyond since 1911. After experiencing its own revitalization a decade ago, FBC Pineville is now a growing, multi-generational church that is reaching Central Louisiana for Christ and investing in other churches through revitalization and planting.

In May of 2022, FBC Pineville adopted FBC Lecompte, Pastor Stewart Holloway's home church, and became one church in two locations. With the adoption, the reach of FBC Pineville extended significantly in Central Louisiana.

FBC Lecompte's history crosses the path of FBC Pineville in at least two significant ways. First, the two churches were both founded by E.O. Ware (Lecompte in 1888 and Pineville in 1911). Second, when Trinity Baptist Church of Lecompte split from FBC Lecompte in 1957, Dr. T.W. Gayer, a retired pastor of FBC Pineville, became their first pastor. FBC Lecompte and Trinity merged in 1993.

With excellent and large facilities located on Hwy. 112 near both Hwy. 71 (.8 miles) and I-49 (1.8 miles), the Lecompte campus is perfectly positioned to reach South Rapides Parish for Christ. Over 10,600 people live within a ten-mile radius of the Lecompte campus. The Lecompte campus is well-maintained, updated, and ready for ministry.

- Direct the planning, coordinating, operation, and evaluation of a comprehensive music ministry, including a graded choir program and oversight of the music ministry budget.
- Direct music groups.
- Oversee the development of a preschool and children's graded choir ministry.
- Develop and oversee the youth ensemble/choir.
- Encourage children and youth to participate in opportunities presented by the local association and the Louisiana Baptist Convention.
- Work in cooperation with the appropriate persons in selecting, enlisting, training, and advising song leaders, accompanists, and other musicians who serve in church program organization.
- Coordinate the performance schedule of music groups and individuals.
- Work with the Pineville Minister of Music to coordinate the training and use of instrumentalists and vocalists in groups or as individuals.
- Assist the Pineville Minister of Music in direction for seasonal productions and events.
- Plan and coordinate concerts at the Lecompte campus.
