
BE FIRST

I'm more excited about what God is doing in our church right now than I have been in the last decade. Even as I type that, it seems so odd. Really? I'm more excited than when we paid off debt in 2012? I'm more excited than when we launched our renovations? I'm more excited than when we finished our renovations? Yes! Here's why - all of that was foundational for where we are today!

I've realized that the last decade was an important time of foundation building. By rebuilding our core ministries, developing a staff, renovating our facilities, and more, we have put ourselves in a great place for exceptional ministry in the days to come. Since moving back into the sanctuary, we have launched new ministries like Man Church, increased our ministry through our website and media, and expanded other ministries like Partner in Education (we now partner with both Pineville Elementary and Lessie Moore Elementary). We also recently made a bold step in bringing on two additional staff members: (1) an additional ministry assistant to help



medical professionals at the hospitals, an encouragement ministry to new moms, an outreach ministry for special needs, and more.



It is amazing how much is launching, and the sky is still the limit if two things happen. First, we need you to get involved. As ministries are mentioned in worship, emails, our website, social media posts, or in our print publications, if you see something you would like to be a part of, contact the person mentioned or the church office, and we'll connect you! Second, we need to give. Even with growing attendance and new ministries, our budget is lagging about \$100,000 behind. Later this month, we'll launch a challenge called 10in10 to help catch up, but you can begin now. Rebecca and I have already bumped up our giving to help make the push to the finish line on December 31. I hope you will join us. Yes, I'm more excited than ever! I've said it before, and I'll say it again, "It's a great time to Be F.I.R.S.T.!"

This past Friday night, October 5, we had a Family Photo Scavenger Hunt! We had 7 families to participate. As we all made our way to Sweet Frog in Pineville, families enjoyed spending time together and taking family photos at random places all over Pineville. When we got to Sweet Frog, you could hear the laughter and chatter all over the room! It was fun to see moms and dads with their children just having a good time! It was great to fellowship with other families around ice cream and to catch up with them to see what God is doing in each of their family's lives!

While it is very important to have our kids involved in church related activities, it is most important to be teaching our children spiritual disciplines. I have been reading a book called Nothing Less by Jana Magruder. In this book the question was asked in her research process, "What spiritual activities are kids doing most?" The answer to me was shocking. Church-related activities top the chart, while personal spiritual activities rank at the bottom. At the top with 62%, children are regularly attending Sunday School or a small group. Ranking the lowest, with 28%, children regularly spend time in prayer. Only 29% of children regularly read their Bible. This book has been a great reminder to me that it is so important for us parents to model for our children the spiritual disciplines. These spiritual disciplines are studying the Bible, prayer, giving and worshiping. 
