F.I.R.S.T. Kid's Corner

The Beginning of a school year and ministry year are always packed with meetings and to-do-lists and trying to get back into a routine at home, work, and church. This year in Preschool and Children's Ministry we have started with a bang! It has been exciting to see God working and moving and growing our ministry!



Wednesday evenings kicked off with our Splash Bash at Kees Park. It was awesome to see families visiting and connecting with one another! I owe a thank you to Tyan and Kenny McNeely and their cooking crew! We started our Wednesday night classes on August 22 and we had 34 children and 15 preschoolers in our Music and Missions classes. Our Sunday School classes are drawing guests every week with an average of 32 preschoolers and 48 children each week! As you enter the Preschool and Children Suite on Sunday and Wednesday you can feel a spirit of excitement and the Spirit of the Lord. Our God is at work in the lives of our families and He is drawing families to our church.

Each week as children come into our areas, they are greeted by our precious volunteers! During our Sunday School hour every week, it takes 16 volunteers in Preschool, 13 volunteers in Children's area, and 11 volunteers in Extended Teaching Care. That is 40 volunteers to love on, care for, and teach the Word of God to our F.I.R.S.T. Kids! Each Wednesday night in Music and Missions, we have 4 childcare workers, 5 Preschool music and missions leaders, and 14 Children's music and missions leaders!

The Lord has grown our Wednesday night activities, so much so, that we needed to add a younger children's choir, Grades 1-3. This will allow our choirs to continue to grow and to let them learn about music on their age level in a fun and exciting way! I am thankful that the Lord stirred in the hearts of our new choir teachers, Julie Tryon and Beth Ingalls, to serve in this ministry! As we grow, we will need more volunteers and more classes! What an AWESOME opportunity to serve the Lord! Are you a willing vessel to be used by God to serve?

One of my areas of focus this year is to connect to the whole family, not just the children! It is my desire that our families would be comfortable to have faith talks with their children, that it would be natural to have spiritual conversations with your family throughout the week! Let's invest in our children's spiritual "schooling" and not just their education in the school system they attend. They are both so important. I leave you with the following verse from Deuteronomy 11: 18-20, "Fix these words of mine in your hearts and minds; tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. Teach them to your children, talking about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates."


